Let's Have a Fiesta!

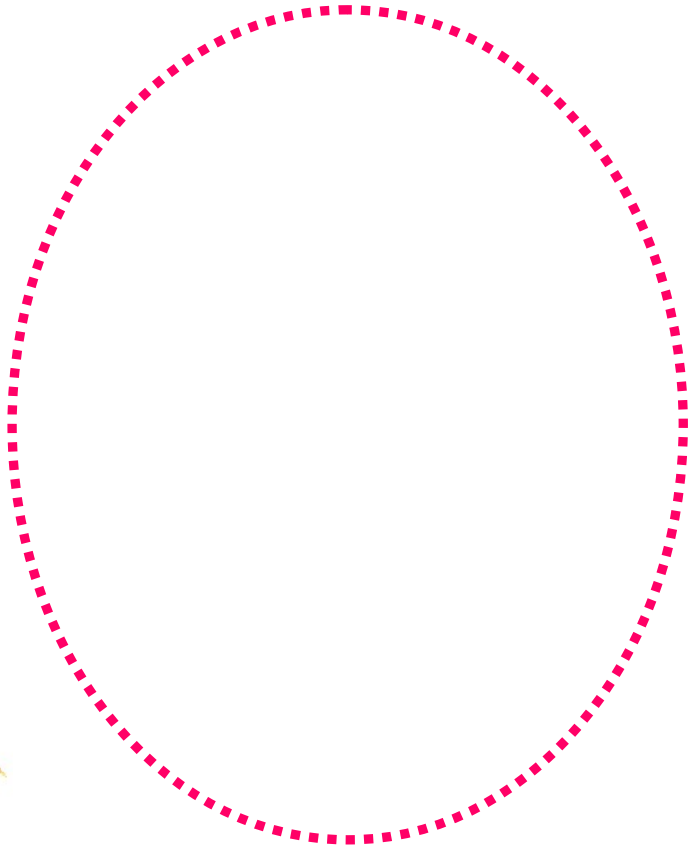
Latin America is the home of Carnival — public celebrations where people dress up, wear masks and play music! Can you find some of our Carnival objects?

Head to the Centenary Gallery and draw in the pieces to complete them

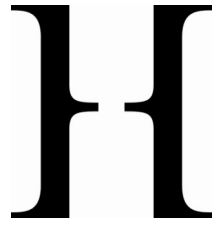


Now draw your own Carnival mask
